E COURSE REPORT

Over the weekend of February 12th to the 14th, Titusville Soccer Club hosted the FYSA E License instructional coaching course. This course brought together 20 coaches from all over the state of Florida, whose enthusiasm and thirst for knowledge remained constant throughout the whipping winds and chilly temperatures that hampered the course. The level of camaraderie and love of the game that these coaches shared, made the weekend's course one of the best that TSC has ever hosted. These coaches proved the point that super-star skill on the soccer pitch is not half as important as heart, determination and the willingness to get out there and have some fun. The course was a great representation of TSC's steadfast commitment to improving the coaching standards of the coaches at TSC as well as other coaches from around the state of Florida and abroad.

7 Goal Rule For In-House Play

This applies to in-house recreational play only. For the age groups U10 & above, when one team is leading by 7 goals, they have to withdraw a player whilst this differential exists. Should that team score again, they then must withdraw another, etc. Should the other team score, then the leading team may bring back one player for each goal that reduces the deficit. For U8 & below, should a team fall behind by 7 goals, the reverse is applicable, as they can add a player for each goal conceded. The key for coaches is to ensure restraint and exercise common sense and fair play.
