Sean Dolan (23), a former TSC player, passed away in an automobile accident earlier this year and his former coach Jim Treinen and family have established an annual scholarship award in his memory. Sean played soccer at TSC for approximately twelve years and twice during the time he was on Jim's comp team, he was an integral part in their Regional B Championship winning side. Without doubt, this was the most successful boys' team to date, to come through the club's ranks. Sean was an excellent soccer player, but more than that, he was an outstanding individual and was loved by all.
