SAFETY FIRST – LIGHTNING SYSTEM

A state-of-the-art Thorguard lightning system was installed at COL this past spring. We are the only complex in the county with this system. When lightning is detected, a long siren will be heard and a flashing beacon activates at the Parks & Rec maintenance building. The all-clear is given with 3 short blasts of the siren and the beacon turns off. If the lightning detector goes off, there are two options: Enter the meeting room (if open) or immediately go to your vehicle. The latter is the preferred option. The pavilion is not rated as an approved shelter for lightning.
